

Guidelines for Roundtable Discussions Roundtable Discussions:

60 minutes

A roundtable discussion allows a group of speakers to present their points of view on one of the key themes of the conference, or another topic of interest to the IACCP membership. Roundtables take the format of 3 to 4 speakers moderated by a chair, who will discuss, criticize, debate or introduce a topic and perspectives on a topic.

The Roundtable Discussion Chair is encouraged to invite presenters from different institutions, and preferably from different regions/ countries/ research labs.

Roundtable Submission Structure:

Thematic Streams: Please choose one or several thematic streams. If you are unsure which stream to choose, contact the organising committee. It is expected that roundtables will be submitted on topics relevant to the main theme of the conference. However, we welcome submissions on any topics of relevance to the IACCP membership and encourage potential applicants to get in touch with the scientific committee if in doubt.

Preferred Mode of Presentation: Please select "Roundtable Discussion."

Title of Roundtable Discussion: Please choose a brief title that clearly indicates the content of the contribution. Please avoid abbreviations in the title.

Brief Content Description: (to appear in the IACCP 2023 Programme): Please ensure that your brief description of the Roundtable Discussion contains no more than 250 characters, including spaces.

Roundtable Discussion Abstract: Please ensure that your abstract contains maximum 300 words. Please explain how each speaker will contribute to the discussion.
