

Guidelines for Symposia Symposia: 90 minutes (including discussion)

A symposium allows a group of speakers to introduce different perspectives and research around a shared theme in a combined 90-minute session, and interact with interested attendees in a discussion during the Conference. The symposium Chair is encouraged to invite presenters from different institutions, and preferably from different regions/ countries/ research labs. However, if the symposia is from a larger research project, several talks covering different aspects of the project are also encouraged and welcome.

The format of a 90-minute symposium usually consists of a brief introduction by the Chair, followed by 3 to 5 presentations. The Chair can also be one of the presenters.

The symposium may optionally end with an overview of the symposium by the Chair or a Discussant. Discussions with the audience should be moderated by the symposium Chair, in the allocated time of 90 minutes.

The Chair is responsible for submitting the whole symposium through the IACCP 2023 abstract submission system, and for being the corresponding author for this symposium.

The Chair of an accepted symposium is also responsible for ensuring that all the symposium presenters are registered by the presenters' registration deadline.

Symposium Submission Structure:

Thematic Streams: Please choose one or several thematic streams. If you are unsure which stream to choose, contact the organising committee.

Preferred Mode of Presentation: Please select "Symposium."

Title of Symposium: Please choose a brief title that clearly indicates the content of the contribution. Please avoid abbreviations in the title.

Brief Content Description: (to appear in the IACCP 2023 Programme): Please ensure that your brief description of the Symposium contains no more than 250 characters, including spaces.

Symposium Abstract: Please ensure that your abstract contains maximum 300 words. Please avoid diagrams, illustrations, tables, references or graphics in the abstract. Provide maximum relevant information in the abstract.

Chair: Names, highest educational degree obtained, email address, phone number, complete mailing address, affiliated institution, and institution country and city.

Presentations (3-5):

Participant (Speaker/First author): Names, highest educational degree obtained, email address, country, affiliated institution, and institution country and city.

Title of the Presentation: Please choose a brief title that clearly indicates the content of the contribution. Please avoid abbreviations in the title.

Abstract of the Presentation: Please ensure that each abstract contains maximum 300 words. Please avoid diagrams, illustrations, tables, references or graphics in the abstract. Provide maximum relevant information in the abstract.

If the subject matter is empirical, the following structure is obligatory: The objective, methods, results, and conclusions.

Co-Authors: Only Names and Institutional Affiliations are required.

Keywords: Please indicate up to 3 keywords for your symposium abstract.

Discussant(s) (optional) (up to 3): Names, highest educational degree obtained, email address, country, affiliated institution, and institution country and city.
